

Title - Regularly asked questions about teacher training with GORSE SCITT

Before applying for teacher training, it's really important to look into the eligibility and requirements for providers. Our central team here at GORSE SCITT have put together some regularly asked questions and answers to help you in completing an application.

Q- How to I apply for teacher training?

A- *Teacher training applications are made via UCAS, the link to make an account and apply is found here <https://2020.teachertraining.apply.ucas.com/apply/student/login.do>
You can apply to three different providers on here.*

Q- How do I know if I am eligible?

A- *Candidates must have a bachelors degree at a minimum of a 2:2 or above, along with GCSE Maths and English Language at grade C/4 or above, if you are interested in teaching primary you will also be required to have GCSE science at grade C/4 or above. Candidates who have studied overseas will require a NARIC Statement of Comparability, details of eligibility are found here <https://getintoteaching.education.gov.uk/eligibility-for-teacher-training>*

Q- Where do I find information regarding the subjects you offer?

Q- Where do I find information regarding the schools I could be placed in?

On UCAS you will be asked to input a campus code, this is a letter or number which refers to one of our partner schools where you would like to be placed on one of your placements with us.*

Q- How do I fund the programme?
